Compost

- Layer mulch or oak leaves
- Turn and water compost

Worm Farm

- Feed worms and check bin
- Prepare worm tea

Irrigation

- Fertilize the beds with worm tea
- Water beds

Seeds and Seedlings

- Feed the seeds on seed table
- Communicate with Mrs. Rigberg and Mrs. O'Kelley about new plantings

Maintenance Crew

- Weeding! Then, More Weeding!
- Prune and trellis adult plants
- Pest control
- Harvest
